### PINOT GRIGIO (*Pinot Gris*)

House (*selections will change*)

Via Firenze, *Italy 2005*

Delicate lemon aromas and flavors, crisp and minerally.

Trinity Oaks, *California*

Spicy aromas of citrus melons, pears, and mineral.

Eola Hills, *Willamette Valley, Oregon, 2005*

Fresh Bartlett Pear aroma. Light, refreshing, and a little fruity with a light finish. A little spritz on the finish. Stainless steel fermented. Italian style Pinot Grigio.

Sparr Pinot Gris Reserve, *Alsace, France*

Clear gold, with pleasant melon and grapefruit aromas.

### SAUVIGNON BLANC

House (*selections will change*)

The Jibe, *Marlborough County, New Zealand*

Youthful, refreshing fruit flavors overlay ripe vegetal flavors.

Robert Mondavi Fume Blanc, *Napa Valley, California*

Vibrant fruit character overlays bright citrus, apricot and melon.

Cloudy Bay, *Marlborough, Australia*

Subtle with lime, passion fruit, green apple and grapefruit flavors.

La Doucette Pouilly-Fume, *Loire Valley, France*

Good crisp texture with lemon, honeysuckle, and mineral notes.

### CHARDONNAY

House (*selections will change*)

Toasted Head, *California*

Heavy oak. Tangerine pear and butterscotch notes with clove and nutmeg.

Macon-Lugny Les Charmes, *Maconnais, Burgundy (Unoaked)*

Fresh, bright and clean with lingering undertones of apple.

Barossa Valley Vineyards Spires, *Barossa, Australia*

Ripe melon, peach, and tropical fruit flavors are the signature of this wine.

Chilcas, *Maule Valley, Chile, 2005*

Lots of melon, lime, and fig with clove from oak ageing, Full bodied with dry finish.

Trinity Oaks, *California*

Aromas of apple and citrus with delicate floral notes of honeysuckle.

Chalone Vineyards, *Monterey, California*

Exotic tropical fruit flavors mix with ripe mango pineapple and green pear.

Hayman and Hill Reserve, *Russian River Valley*

Full bodied fruit and a core of peach, apple, and spice with minimal oak.

Coppola Diamond Collection

Golden apple and exotic fruits. Finishes with vanilla from french oak ageing.

Flora Springs Barrel Fermentation, *Napa Valley*

Elegant and delicate, showing rich subtle fig, nectarine, and tangerine.

Cakebread, *Napa Valley*

Impressively concentrated flavors of pear, apple, guava, and banana.

### RIESLING

House (*selections will change*)

Trinity Oaks, *California*

Refreshing honeysuckle flavors with hints of peach and apricot.

Hogue Late Harvest, *Columbia Valley, Washington*

Sweet and appealing with ripe pear and honey aromas finishing with starfruit.

Sparr, *Alsace, France*

Bone dry classic Alsace Riesling balanced with citric and tangy apple-like flavors.

### OTHER WHITES

Covey Run Gewurztraminer, *Columbia Valley, California*

Floral nose with lychee nuts and citrus fruits. Blending in 11% muscat grapes.

Grover Viognier, *Nandi Hills, India*

Clean and light. Rounded acidity and spicy notes of green pepper.

Ledgewood Creek Roussanne, *Suisan Valley, California*

Fresh, fruit, and lively with little oak. Added 15% Viognier adds floral components.

### SPARKLING

Banfi Rosa Regale

Unique red sparkler. Aromatic with a hint of rose petals.

Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin, *Yellow Label, Champagne, France*

White fruit and raisons with vanilla and brioche.

Dom Perignon, *Champagne, France, Vintage 1998*

Honey, vanilla, and light coffee. Well balanced, fine and vibrant. WS Rating 91

Krug Brut, *Champagne, France Vintage 1995*

Super texture like velvet with coconut, ginger, vanilla, and tobacco. WS Rating 95

### DESSERT WINES

Bonny Doon Book of Love Framboise (*375 ml*)

Fortified raspberry wine with grape flavors added. Very sweet and rich.

Three Rivers Biscuit Ridge Late Harvest Gewurztraminer (*375 ml*)

Nose of sandalwood and citrus. Taste of honey and burnt caramel.

Covey Run Late Harvest Riesling, *Columbia Valley Washington*

Like a sweet crisp apple with bits of tropical fruit.

Kiona Ice Wine, *Washington (375 ml)*

Chenin Blanc grapes frozen on the vine. Sports balance of acids and sweetness.

## Red Wine

### PINOT NOIR

**Hayman and Hill Reserve, Santa Lucia, California**  
Light in structure with strawberries and cherries.

**Trinity Oaks, California**  
Bright black cherries with hints of tobacco and mint.

**Hidden Jewel, Central Coast, California**  
Deeply colored with pure extraction of dark cherries and loads of spice.

**High Vines, Languedoc, France, 2005**  
Light-medium in body. Black raspberries, cherries, earth, and spice, with light oak. Well balanced.

**Angeline, Russian River, California**  
Ruby colors with bright fruit flavors of raspberry and strawberry with slight vanilla.

### MERLOT

**House (selections will change)**  
**LaRoche, Languedoc-Roussillon, France**  
Rounded with slightly spicy berries, mulberries, and hints of minerals.  
**Leal Estate Grown, San Benito**  
Juicy black fruits and spice. Soft, creamy and refined with silky texture.

### SHIRAZ AND SYRAH

**Rex Goliath Free Range, California**  
Lush flavors of jammy red fruit and plum on soft tannins.  
**Paringa, South Australia, 2005**  
Heavy and full with blackberry and spice. Aftertaste of tobacco and vanilla.  
**Steele Shooting Star, Lake County, California**  
Medium bodied with raspberry and black pepper  
**Hayman and Hill (Shiraz-Viognier Blend), Monterey, California**  
Raspberry dominates with low tannins. 7% Viognier adds hint of herbal complexities  
**Coppola Diamond Collection, California**  
Generous aromas of plum and clove with palate of ripe raspberry and black currant.  
**Greg Norman, Limestone Coast, Australia**  
Dark berry, plum and ripe cherry flavors with spicy oak  
**Bon Cap Organic, South Africa**  
Loads of white and black pepper with spicy flavors supported by ripe cherry

### BORDEAUX AND MERITAGE BLENDS

**Hayman and Hill Reserve, Monterey 2003**  
(41 M, 38 CS, 10 CF, 7 PV, 4 Mal)  
Slight tobacco on nose black cherry and firm tannins.  
**Rothschild Mouton Cadet, Bordeaux (55 M, 30 CS, 15 CF)**  
Intense blackberry aromas and floral nose. Round and crisp.  
**Clos Les Lunelles, Bordeaux, France (80 M, 10 CS, 10 CF)**  
Super intensity, powerful palate, silky tannins and mineral laden backbone.  
**St Supery ELU, Napa Valley, 2001 (80 CS, 14 M, 4 CF, 2 PV)**  
Intensity and concentration of cherry and vanilla, rose petal and cassis.  
**Opus One, Napa Valley, 2003 (86 CS, 6 M, 3 CF, 3 Mal, 2 PV)**  
Aromas of blackberry, plum, hazelnut, graphite, cocoa, and dried cherries.

### ZINFANDEL

**Ravenswood Vintner's Blend**  
Beautiful blend of berries, zippy spice, and well-balanced finish.  
**Hayman and Hill, Dry Creek Valley, California**  
Ripe cherry and coffee characteristics abound in this full-bodied wine.  
**Peachy Canyon, Paso Robles, California**  
Smiky licorice and cherry aromas with zesty plum and black pepper.

### CABERNET SAUVIGNON

**House (selections will change)**  
**McManis, California, 2005**  
Distinctive blackberry aroma layered with hints of clove and mocha. Fruit on palate has richness and density. A roasted heavy toast oaken finish lingers.  
**Hayman and Hill Reserve, Napa Valley, California**  
Ripe blackberry with hint of spice and black olive.  
**Steele Shooting Star, Lake County, 2005**  
Aromas of dark fruits with mint and cassis.  
**Seven Hills, Walla Walla Valley, Washington**  
Ripe and resonant with minty cedary cherry currant and plum flavors. WS Rating 92  
**Joseph Phelps, Napa Valley, California**  
Elegant style with ripe, vibrant, well-defined black cherry and cedar. WS Rating 88

### OTHER REDS

**Fleur du Cap Pinotage, Coastal South Africa**  
Ruby plummy supported by soft tannins and medium body.  
**Monasterio de Santa Ana**  
100% Monastrell. Vanilla aromas, silky and full bodied with long after-taste.  
**Vivacious Vicky Rose, Washington**  
Fruity aromas and flavors reminiscent of summer berries, cranberries and orange blossoms.  
**Vina Robles Red 4, Paso Robles California**  
**Petit Syrah, Touriga, Tannat, and Syrah.**  
Full-bodied and with dark fruits and spice.  
**Saurus Patagonia Select Malbec, Argentina**  
Combination of red fruit especially cherry with oaky vanilla.  
**Steele Shooting Star Blue Franc, Washington State**  
Little oak ageing. Clean crisp and unpretentious with pepper, almond and cinnamon.  
**Produttori de Barbaresco, Italy, 2002**  
100% Nebbiolo. Medium-bodied vintage with lively and spicy aromas.  
**Paul Jaboulet Chateaufeuf du Pape Les Cedres, France, 2003**  
Intense bouquet, rich and complex with aromas of very ripe red fruit and soft spices.  
**Coldisole Brunello di Montalcino, Italy, 2000**  
Thick and chewy with blackberry and tobacco. Full bodied with long finish. WS Rating 90  
**Antinori Tignanello, Tuscany, Italy, 2003**  
Super Tuscan. Subtle complex aromas of licorice, dried flowers and full-bodied palate. WS Rating 91
